The “9th Annual Bush Camp” for the 26th (WA) Eastern Hills Boys Brigade Company is fast approaching. We will be staying on a property off Asher Road, Paulls Valley. It will be a great opportunity to spend time together, practise the things we have been learning and undertake some confidence building activities. The weekend will contain both devotional and physical activities and all Junior Boys that attend will participate in the entire weekend.

We will be meeting at The Connection Centre at 4pm on Friday 5th August to pack and then travel by car pool to camp. We will return at 12 noon on Sunday the 7th August. The total cost for Junior Boys is \$65 per Boy. Attached is a list of requirements. We strongly suggest using the boxes beside the list of required items as check boxes.

Boys will be preparing and cooking their own meals in much the same way we have been cooking over the last few weeks on a Thursday night. Each morning and evening we will be presenting a short devotional. Other activities will include games, practical skills, lantern stalk and all things camping.

Weather permitting, we will run some activities on the dam.

Baggage Allowance

We will allow 3 pieces of luggage per boy.

1 clothing bag. This is a bush camp. Do not send your favourite light coloured designer label clothing or bag.

1 swag or mattress. (Please roll tight and tie with a belt.)

1 bag of blankets/sleeping bag and pillow.

In addition to the above list, we have always suggested the boys pack into their main clothes bag, 6 large rubbish bags clearly marked with the items of clothing inside each bag as per instructions below. This is a bush camp with no access to washing machines or drying equipment. In the event your child does not have sufficient dry/warm clothing, anytime throughout the weekend, we will be requesting you pick up your child. The idea is that each time they change, the clean dry clothes come out of a specific clearly marked bag, and the dirty and wet clothing will be placed back into the garbage bags each time they change.

I am aware however, that there are many Boys who manage to stay clean enough as no not need a change of clothes over the weekend period. I am more concerned about WET than dirty. Please consider the following.
